1- View the screeners by clicking on the links below, and if you're interested in anything, email me for my licensing rates @ smcpartland@psphoto.com

2- Send along a detailed list including the screener file name(s), and the time code in/out points for each clip you're interested in. At that point I'll let you know what the total cost will be for licensing said video. Note, there is a 10 second minimum required.

3- I will email you my standard one page licensing agreement already filled out with your specific licensing information. Review, sign and either email or fax it back to me. Or, if you have a license agreement of your own, I will review it.

4- At this point I can post the video to my server and email you private links to the video for you to download (this is the most requested method of delivery). A master dub can also be supplied on tape if need be (HDV or Mini DV tape only). In this case you must pay the shipping charges.

5- Once the license agreement is squared away, I will submit an invoice which can be paid via PayPal if preferred, or via company check within 45 days of date on invoice.

6- *Note* HDV Footage can be supplied on HDV tape, or in the following file formats: Native M2T (1440 X 1080), Quick Time HD (1440 X 1080, 1280 X 720 or 1920 X 1080)

2.26.10 Queens, NY

February 26th, 2010 Major Snow Storm NEW (HDV 1080i)

As the winter of 2009/2010 wore on, yet another major winter storm impacted the NYC area, and this time we received almost 20 inches in Central Park!! This storm made it official, we now had experienced our snowiest month EVER here in NYC! This storm hit hard, and it hit early with the most intense bands of snows moving into Queens, NY right after sunrise. I headed out and captured a ton of great video which included an MTA city bus spinning his tires, and another one that had crashed into a bus stop. Other shots include folks out and about negotiating snow covered streets, traffic along the Long Island Expressway, cars buried under all the snow, and people digging out.

Video shows tourists and locals alike having an impromptu snow ball fight in the middle of Times Square, folks braving the elements, holiday decorations adorning a snow covered city, heavy snow falling, land mark shots, and much more.

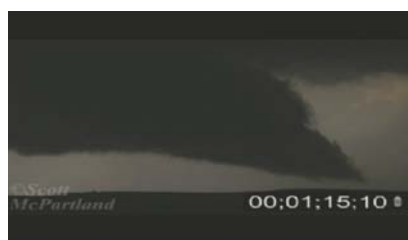
2008/2009 New York City Snowstorm/Winter Weather Footage (HDV 1080i)

Shots of traffic signals out, pedestrians directing traffic, police and other law enforcement agencies out and about, police directing traffic, people climbing down off the LIRR, long lines at stores for essentials, shots of the New York City skyline completely dark, sundown shots, people out with candles, people walking through their homes with candles, dark street shots, following morning shots at sunrise (power still out), long lines at the bus stops, subways blocked off, etc..

PAL Information:

If you need Standard Definition footage delivered in PAL format, this can be done. However, for the time being I can only deliver in PAL format via a video file, not on actual tape. Below is a list of PAL formats that I can convert the original NTSC video to:

Microsoft DV AVI (PAL 25fps 720 X 576)
MPEG 2 (PAL 25fps 720 X 576)
Quick Time (PAL 25fps 720 X 576)

With PAL requests, I can either burn the video that you've selected for licensing in the file format of your choice to a DVD and ship that to you. You can then export the video file right off the DVD, onto the hard drive, and into your editor. Or, I can post the video to my server and email you private links for you to download it (this is the most requested method of delivery).
